8 Make a card for someone who is having a hard time.

9 Ask God to open your eyes to see what He's doing around you.

10 Ask God to show you what He wants to do in you.

11 Start a Family Prayer Journal to keep track of God's work in your midst.

12 Say, *Jesus is always with me*, until you feel like this truth took a deep root in your

13 Take turns telling every member of the family what you like about them.

14 When you feel you can't do something, add the word "yet."



15 Memorize Psalm 27:1

16 Ask God to show you what He wants to do in you.

17 Read Psalm 138 out loud. Make it your prayer.

18 Take turns talking about one time when God became very real to you.

19 Be still for a few minutes and simply enjoy God.

20 Set aside some of your own money to place in the offering at church.

21 Pray for someone whose name starts with the letter D.



22 Make a list of people who don't know Jesus. Start praying for them.

23 Ask God to show you what He wants to do through you.

24 Tell God about something fun or exciting that happened to you lately.

25 Take turns talking about one thing God has been teaching you lately.

26 Tell God about the worst thing that ever happened to you.

27 Discuss as a family: Do you think you have a guardian angel?

28 Take turns finishing the sentence: Wow God, You are.....



29 Pray for your neighbors.

30 Read 1 John 3:18. Discuss what this means with your family.

31 Do you have a "mountain" in your life? Talk to God about it.
